MINUTES OF THE NORTHWEST REGIONAL COUNCIL December 7, 2023

BOARD MEMBERS:

The meeting was called to order at 10:04 am by Island County Commissioner Jill Johnson.

There was no public comment.

Island County Commissioner Jill Johnson requested that all motions be moved to the front of the agenda.

Consent Agenda

Motion was made by Island County Commissioner Melanie Bacon and Seconded by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning to approve the Consent Agenda items a – f: Approval of the Minutes, July 10, 2023 and August 18, 2023: Approval of June, July, August, September, and October 2023 Expenditure Listings: 2023 Budget to Actual Report: Cancellation of Warrants, Resolution #22-03: Annual Internal Fiscal System Review: Routine Contracts and Amendments. The Motion passed unanimously.

Regular Agenda

a) NWRC 2024 Budget #23-02

NWRC Executive Director Amanda McDade provided an overview of the 2024 budget request of \$28.3 million. The 2024 budget represents a 3% increase from the current year which includes a net increase of 3 FTE's, reclassification salary adjustment, updated salary schedule and 3% COLA for staff. In addition, allows for some growth of our reserves/fund balance. There was a question and discussion about if there is any forecasted relief in available caregivers for older adults. There was also a question and discussion about how successful the market adjustment was for the Behavioral Health clinicians.

Motion was made by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning and seconded by San Juan County Council Member Christine Minney to approve Resolution #23-02 for the 2024 budget. Motion passed unanimously.

b) Reclassifications & Market Base Salary adjustment

NWRC Executive Director Amanda McDade discussed the need to adjust the BH Program Supervisor role based on a market rate study and establish its own job description, called out from other supervisory roles in the agency. In addition, she reviewed the need to reclassify our NEMT MAP Administrative Aide to Customer Service Representative which would allow the agency to cross train staff in this department allowing for more

trained professionals to handle the increasing volume of calls and additional flexibility for coverage when staff is out of the office.

Motion was made by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning and seconded by San Juan County Council Member Christine Minney to approve the proposed reclassification of one Case Management Program Supervisor to a Behavioral Health Program Supervisor placed on Range 2 of the 2023 salary schedule and the reclassification of MAP Administrative Aide (1.75 FTE) to the position of Customer Service Representative, effective January 1, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

c) Proposed Policy Updates

NWRC Executive Director Amanda McDade provided a general overview of the proposed policy changes. There was discussion about the need to update the agency driver's policy and required employee insurance coverage. A request was made to have more information about the required changes and the potential impact to staff.

Motion was made by Whatcom County Executive Satpal Sidhu and seconded by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning to approve the policy changes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

d) Salary Schedule Expansion & Reclassification

NWRC Executive Director Amanda McDade discussed the recent examination of our existing compensation structure and market rate analyses conducted by our HR department. The current salary structure has anywhere from 2.75% to 18.56% increases in compensation between the 10 ranges. Expanding our ranges from 10 to 20 ranges reduces the variance down to between ranges of 2.75% - 5.3% offering greater flexibility. One role that has been limited by the existing salary schedule is the Dementia Program Specialist. Current analysis indicated that we are 2.5% behind market median and 4.4% behind the closest comparable position. Expanding the compensation structure will not change compensation for anyone other than the recommended Dementia Support Specialists. There was a question about the open ranges and acknowledgement that some ranges will remain open, without any jobs assigned within them at this time but will better allow for future growth.

Motion was made by Whatcom County Executive Satpal Sidhu and Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning to adopt the proposed salary schedule expanding to 20 ranges effective January 1, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning and seconded by Whatcom County Executive Satpal Sidhu to approve the proposed reclassification of the Dementia Program Specialist to Range 14 of the 2024 Salary Schedule effective January 1, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

e) 2024 – 2027 Strategic Plan Update

There was discussion about the 2024 – 2027 Strategic Plan (Area Plan Version). Overall, the themes are the same except the Transportation and Jail Health objectives are not included since they are outside the DSHS Aging scope. There were additions made to address Diversity, Equity, and Belonging and social isolation. The Board discussed the meaning of belonging. Island County Commissioner Jill Johnson shared some new learning around the term "belonging" meaning assimilation and the impact of that. Others on the Board shared information leading the group to suggest using the term inclusion instead. The Board did not feel that it needs to be updated in this version, rather moving forward. There was also discussion about clearly

defining terms in the Diversity, Equity, and Belonging section so that readers understand the intent of the words and concepts.

Motion was made by San Juan County Council Member Jane Fuller and seconded by San Juan County Council Member Christine Minney to approve the NWRC 2024 – 2027 Strategic Plan – Area Plan on Aging version. Motion passed unanimously.

f) 2024 Meeting Schedule

The Board reviewed and agreed to the 2024 meeting schedule.

Executive Directors Report

NWRC Executive Director Amanda McDade reviewed the upcoming legislative advocacy efforts for the short session:

- W4A: The nutrition program has been impacted by both the loss of COVID funding and increased community need and there is a large request to increase funding.
- W4A: Long Term Care Clients are increasingly without caregivers. Clients without caregivers need
 more of the case managers time to help them. We are asking for a rate increase to decrease the
 caseloads for those case managers who work with clients that need a caregiver and currently do not
 have one.
- Request for Transportation funding: There are 6 transportation brokers to serve Washington state.
 Administrative rates have been flat for some time while the need and volume has grown. The impact means that there are longer wait times for patients trying to schedule transportation, more abandoned calls, and an inability to respond to short notice trips. There is a request to increase funding that will allow for normal inflation growth.
- WA Cares: NWRC is providing outreach and support for the new WA Cares Fund. We have a tentative
 outline of our outreach plan and are working with the State to determine how people can access their
 funds.

Executive Session

An Executive Session was called at 11:29 am to discuss the Executive Director Performance. The Chair estimated the session would last up to 15 minutes.

The regular board meeting reconvened at 11:50 am. The Board expressed their gratitude for the work that the Executive Director has done, the clear communication, and highlighting other staff's expertise.

Motion was made by San Juan County Council Member Christine Minney and seconded by Skagit County Commissioner Peter Browning to approve a 3% step increase and 3% COLA, consistent with the agency COLA, for the Executive Director starting January 1, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:02 pm.

SUBJECT: Staffing Adjustments

The 2024 budget that you approved was purposefully conservative, which is our aim. We also were unsure about the increase of new case managed clients from the State, as the impact of the pandemic was still being felt across all State systems. However, sooner than we expected, the caseloads in the NWRC Long-Term Care Case Management unit have reached above the contracted ratio of 1:75 throughout the first quarter of 2024, evidencing the need for an additional FTE. In alignment with our funding and departmental goals for long-term care case management, I recommend an increase of 1 FTE for a Long-term Care Case Manager, prior to mid-year budget.

The cost of this additional FTE would be approximately \$58,000 in the first year.

The NWRC Governing Board authorizes the proposed addition of 1 FTE in the Long-Term Care Case Management unit, effective April 18th, 2024.

SUBJECT: Premium Pay for Interpreters

NWRC serves clients from diverse backgrounds, some of whom need to communicate with our staff in a language other than English. With this in mind, and in line with our current strategic plan's increase in DEI investments, we would like to implement a policy which provides an incentive to client-facing employees who obtain certification and/or authorization as a social services interpreter. This equity related initiative not only compensates employees who bring this much needed skill to our workforce, but also better serves NWRC clients with limited English proficiency.

I recommend the following: Introduce a 4% premium pay for employees in client-facing positions who take and pass a Social Services Interpreter test for a certified or screened language (including verbal and written portions) through WA State DSHS Language Testing and Certification Program. This includes staff in behavioral health, community programs, care coordination, case management, front desk, or other staff members at the Executive Director's discretion.

The NWRC Governing Board authorizes the proposed adoption of a 4% premium pay for certified social services interpreters effective June 1st, 2024.

SUBJECT: COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

During the COVID-19 public health emergency, NWRC adopted a COVID-19 vaccination mandate for all new staff which remains in place today. In addition to the COVID-19 public health emergency, which ended May 11, 2023, Governor Inslee rescinded Directive 22-13.1, which required State employees to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. With these in mind we have reexamined the need to maintain our current policy.

With the changing landscape post pandemic, ability for telework, continued sanitation practices still in place at NWRC, and overall high vaccination rate among our workforce, we do not think a COVID vaccination mandate is still necessary.

PROPOSED MOTION #1:

The NWRC Governing Board authorizes the revocation of the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy, no longer requiring new employees to provide proof of vaccination upon hire effective May 1st, 2024.
